## PROJECT TO ORGANIZE EACMC PREPARATION COURSES PART 1 BY AMCC FOR Graduates from outside Canada and the United States (DHCEU)

## Winter 2024: January 13, 2024 - April 13, 2024

To help DHCEUs succeed in the College of Physicians of Canada (CMC) entrance exams, the Association of Cameroonian Physicians of Canada (AMCC) organizes the l'EACMC Part 1 preparation courses for this category of candidates.

The objective is to improve their performance and success rate on this exam.

They will take place over a 3-month period, with one course of 6 to 8 hours per week. The document outlining the objectives of the EACMC Part 1 on the College of Physicians of Canada website is the one used as a reference for the subjects chosen. Topics will be selected according to their frequency in current practice, their likelihood of occurrence during the examination, and their level of difficulty, particularly for this category of candidate. Consequently, not all topics will be covered.

Courses will be delivered online. The teaching staff are mostly physicians in independent practice in the Canadian medical system in various specialties, medical residents or DHCEUs following the medical clerkship route. Each presentation will take the form of a clinical case study, followed by questions to help you delve deeper into the subject and convey the key points to remember. Each instructor will decide whether or not to provide his or her own didactic material (handouts, slides, etc.). Candidates will be able to ask questions only on the subject they are working on during the session. Please note that a Facebook group exists for AMCC members with an DHCEU profile, where they can ask more general questions about the Canadian system and/or seek advice/opinions on the admission process to this system.

Priority is given to candidates who are members of the Association des médecins Camerounais du Canada. A total of 20 places are available for all candidates. If there are still places available, other candidates who are not members of the AMCC will be able to register.

At the start of the 3-month period, candidates will be given a typical mock exam (short format) taken directly from the College of Physicians of Canada website. This allows candidates to familiarize themselves with the exam from the outset, and to direct their preparation.

The entire organizing team will also be on hand to optimize their preparation outside the sessions. Our aim is to ensure that everyone succeeds with flying colors.

Our aim is to contribute to the success of each participant, so we require attendance at all sessions. However, we understand that there may be constraints leading to absence. To help us achieve this, we have set out a few rules to be respected by each candidate:

- Participate fully in at least 2/3 of courses
- One absence from 4 classes or less is tolerated. The 4th absence will lead to exclusion from the course without reimbursement of registration fees.

N.B All registered candidates undertake to "give back" in the years to come. In other words, he/she commits to helping other candidates to succeed by any useful means.

Fees :

- The participation fee is **\$1,100 CAD** per candidate.
- AMCC members receive a **10%** discount.
